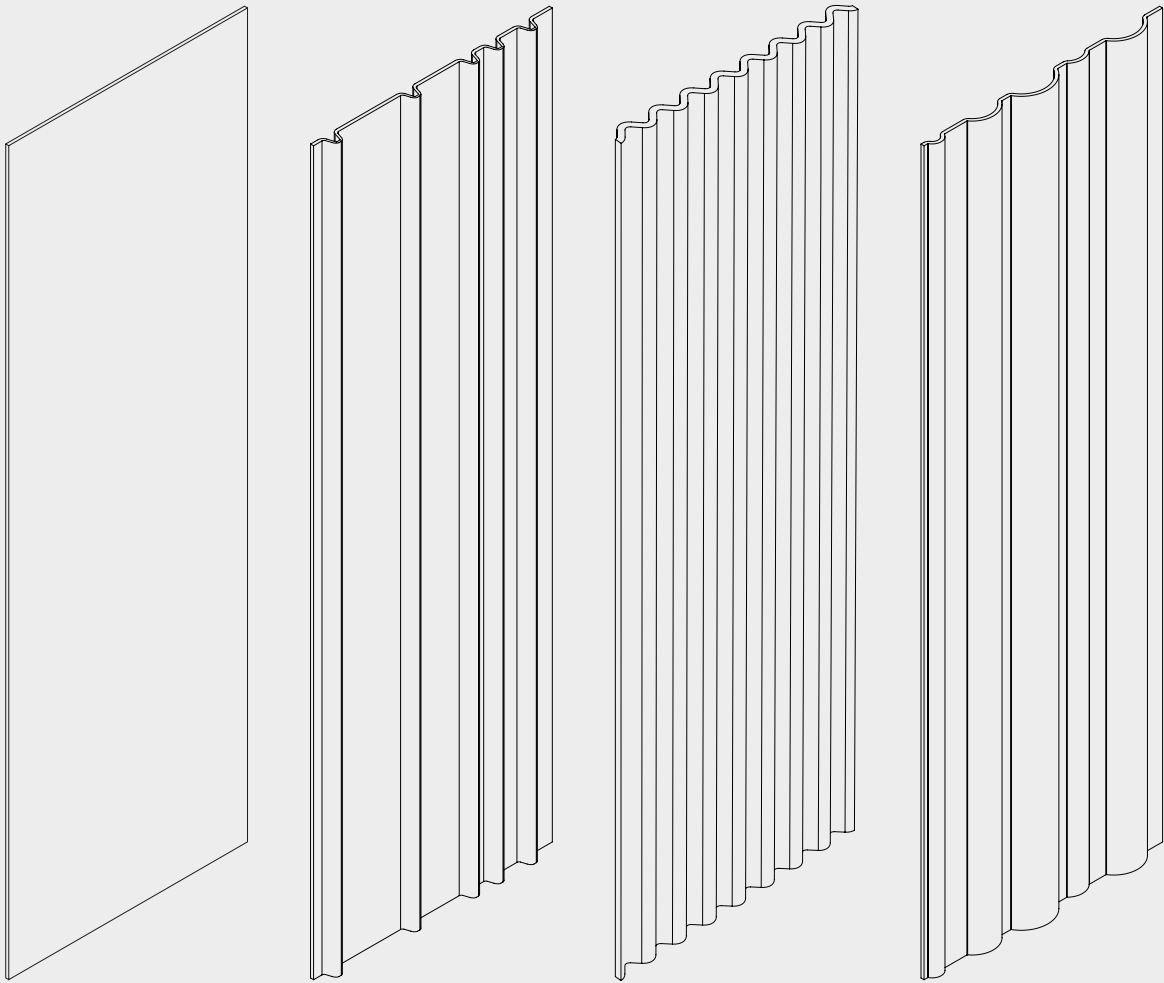

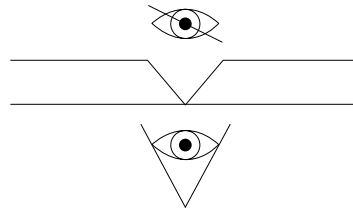

Installation tips

Since Mute PET Felt panels are made of recycled material, they may have slight colour differences - even within the batches of the same production run. This is caused by the nap direction of PET Felt material, which may be visually strengthened by the incidence of light.

1. We recommend to always lay out the panels in the desired pattern before final installation.
2. To achieve the most seamless transition between the panels, it is important to place them tightly against each other. You can do this by firmly pressing a loose panel against the already installed parts before attaching it.
3. If you still find the seam too visible, cutting the panel with a circular saw (and a ruler) at an angle may solve the issue.



4. If you use a circular saw to cut the panels to size, set the saw to a low speed to prevent material from melting. For the same reason, the saw blade shouldn't get too hot.

Stacking Mute panels

The colour differences are more visible between the short sides of the panels than between the long sides. If you want to stack Mute panels, we advise you to use the pattern below to make eventual colour differences less visible.

- Use the panels in the same order they are delivered / stacked.
- Never cut the same panel to fill the missing smaller pieces.
- Always place the cutting side on the outside (ceiling or floor side).
- An asymmetric pattern ensures that the colour differences are less visible.
